1. What is the expansion of TNSCVT?

Tamilnadu State Council of Vocational Training.

2. What is Vocational Training?

Vocational Training prepares students for a specific trade. It prepares people for specific trades, crafts and careers at various levels from a trade, a craft, technician or a high professional practitioner position in careers such as engineering, accountancy, nursing, medicine, architecture, pharmacy, law etc.

3. What are the activities done by TNSCVT?

Tamilnadu State Council of Vocational Training is an examining and certifying body which provides Certificates to successful students.

4. What are all the Modes of Education?

There are Regular and Distance Mode of Education.

5. What is the difference between Regular and Distance Mode?

In the Regular Mode classes will be conducted on a day-to-day basis and attendance will be marked. Internal Assessment, Project, Internship training-all needs to be compulsorily undertaken through the concerned Vocational Training Centre. In the distance mode, students who are already employed and who do not have a certificate in the specified trade will have to appear for exams after duly getting sign in the Internship form Human Resource Manager of the concerned Company. This is done through Industry Internship Education Programme (IIEP).

6. What is Vocational Training Centre?

Vocational Training Centre (VTC) is any one of the affiliated centres of RAM VTC which trains students in any one or more of the trades as specified by TNSCVT.

7. What is Industry Internship Education Programme (IIEP)?

Industry Internship Education Programme has been formulated to focus on students who study courses through distance mode. The students who are already employed but who do not have certificates to prove their skills have to fill in the internship form and get the signature of the employer. The theoretical subjects will be handled at the VTC, while the employee's workplace is his/her practical lab. On completing the internship and passing the exam successfully, they will be certified by TNSCVT.

8. Who is RAM VTC?

RAM Vocational Training Centre is the expansion of RAMVTC. RAMVTC is the National Coordinator of TNSCVT and it conducts classes for courses as specified by TNSCVT and also provides affiliation to Vocational Training Centres across India.

9. What benefits do I get by joining the courses of TNSCVT?

TNSCVT courses have been designed in tune with the current scenario. The courses have been designed as per National Educational Policy, 1986 and National Vocational Education Qualification Framework. The subjects are designed in a simple and lucid manner making it easier to pass the examination. Students who have acquired skills will be able to get jobs easily whereas students who already have skills will be able to move to better and coveted jobs.

10. What is the legal status of TNSCVT?

TNSCVT is a legally established under Government of Tamilnadu and is a sister concern of Tamilnadu Council for Open and Distance Learning which has already acquired ISO 9001:2008 Certification and is a Planning Commission, Govt. of India member. TNSCVT has got a legal responsibility to promote Vocational Education as per Government Guidelines and it will no time deviate from those guidelines.

11. How many times the examination is conducted by TNSCVT?

Examination is conducted two times in a year.

12. Why TNSCVT is charging very less fees?

The main aim of TNSCVT is to promote vocational education to poor people, underprivileged people, widows, ex-servicemen etc. In order to help them we charge very less fees.

13. Why the fees vary from VTC to VTC?

The fees charged by the study centre, depends upon the services they provide like additional training, visual aids etc. However, the candidate should be vigilant and should inform TNSCVT in case if they charge exorbitant fees.

14. What are the Certificates I will be provided on passing the TNSCVT examination?

The passed candidates will be provided mark sheet (transcript) by default. Students who require Transfer Certificate will have to pay an additional Rs.200/- to avail it.

15. How long will it take to despatch the results and mark sheets?

Results will be published in 30-45 days from the date of completion of exam. Similarly mark sheets will be issued in 30-45 days from the date of publication of results.

16. How to avail concession in fees?

To avail concession in fees, the student will have to fill the prescribed form and send Proof of documents. Concession is not transferrable.

17. How can I inform my grievance / complaint?

18. What is the passing threshold in TNSCVT Exams?

All candidates who have obtained a score of 40% are declared to have passed the exam.

19. Do I have to attend classes for courses of TNSCVT?

For courses conducted through Regular Mode, it is compulsory to attend classes and a minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory to appear for exams. For students who have joined in Distance Mode, attending classes are not compulsory and can straight away collect Admit card to appear for examination.

20. What should I do to attend classes?

You are requested to contact your VTC where you have taken admission. They will conduct classes after charging requisite fees.

21. Whether Syllabus is available for the courses offered by TNSCVT?

Yes, you may contact authorized VTC office for getting the requisite syllabus.

22. Whether TNSCVT requires the approval of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) ?

As per AICTE, since TNSCVT conducts one-year diploma courses, it does not come under the purview of AICTE via notification **F.No.14-462/RTI/PIO/PC/2014 dated 03-12-2014**

23. Whether TNSCVT should become a member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU)?

Since the membership of the Association is open only to Universities and since that TNSCVT is an Autonomous Council it does not require to be a member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU) via notification **Ref No: RT/2015/1069 dated 19-01-2015**

24. Whether Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) has approved TNSCVT?

IGNOU-SOVET has given its nod to conduct the TNSCVT courses via notification **D/S OVER/10621 dated 19-12-2014**

25. Whether Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD)has approved TNSCVT?

MHRD has indirectly said that TNSCVT can conduct Vocational Education courses as the courses that need approval are listed in www.aicte-india.org via notification **F.No.4-1/2013NVEQF** and already it has been informed by AICTE that TNSCVT Courses does not come under the purview of AICTE.

26. Whether students of TNSCVT can register their certificates in Directorate of Employment and Training & Employment Exchanges in Tamilnadu State?

Yes, it is possible to register TNSCVT certificates in Employment Exchanges in Tamilnadu State via
